





WORSHIP AND STUDY


With autumn fast approaching, we have a couple of special days coming up in the next couple of months for us to look forward to!

October 1st is World Communion Sunday. On this day, churches all around the world acknowledge together that Jesus Christ is the head of the Church universal, and that every Christian church is breaking bread together, as one. As usual, Bethel will be providing a basket full of different ethnic breads from around the world for you to choose from to dip into the juice. 
